




#### City of Helsinki Urban Development Areas

- Location at the intersection of East and West makes Helsinki an attractive region for companies to expand their business.











### Flow of soils and processed stones

# Surplus soils management

- 1. Guidance and control of design and construction
- 2. Soil flow coordination: there is communication among construction and storage sites.
- 3. Sites for temporary storage and processing effective utilisation and refining
  - effective utilisation and refining
- 4. Development projects, e.g. Absoils, UUMA 2;
  - developing and fostering new methods
- 5. Securing the existence of disposal areas.

The operational objective of the Public Works Department in Helsinki for the year 2015 is:
